- People living in Brisbane, Logan and Ipswich City
- from a multicultural background
- complex health and social needs
- all age groups
- permanent residents and any other visa holder (except people in detention)

Activities

- Assessment of your health needs
- Health education on health conditions, medications, and health systems
- Help with referral to other services (Eg: housing, employment services, financial support, GPs and medical specialists)
- The program will work with your family and carers as needed
- The program is free
